BINDING CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All exhibitors must conform to the Rules and By-laws of the Society.
2. The Ipswich Orchid Society Inc. or its agents will accept no responsibility for theft, loss, destruction, or damage to any plants, either during transport to and from the show venue, or while at the show venue.
3. All participants of the show must adhere to Fire Ant Regulations.
4. All plants must be free of pests and disease. The Show Marshall, Chief Steward, and Sales Co-Ordinator reserve the right to refuse any plant which appears to be affected by pest or disease.

EXHIBITION

1. Entries are free but only open to current members of an Orchid Society.
2. If you are not a member of Ipswich Orchid Society, you are a Visitor and therefore must complete a Visitor's Registration Form to obtain your Exhibitor Number.
3. All plants entered must be the property of the exhibitor and have been in the exhibitor's possession for a minimum of six months.
4. No exhibition plant shall be removed from the show until the termination of the show. Removal of a plant may result in forfeiture of prizes and exhibitor's disqualification at future shows.
5. Every exhibition plant must have an exhibition tag. Digital copies of the exhibition tags can be requested via the society email. Printed cards will be available at the show.
6. Entries will be accepted from 3:00pm and must be benched by 6:00pm during the Friday setup. Judging will commence at 7:00pm.
7. The Show Marshall and Chief Steward reserve the right to:
 - a) Reject any entry.
 - b) Adjust any entry's class or arrangement.
 - c) Make adjustments to the show schedule on the night of judging.
8. No bloom may be removed from a plant, even though spent, or plants or blooms interfered with, without the permission of the Chief Steward or other appointed official. Stealing of blooms or pollen may lead to legal action.
9. Plants will be judged according to AOC standards.
10. Grand Champion shall be selected from the Class Champions. Reserve Champion shall be selected from the remaining Class Champions plus the second best orchid from the class which the Grand Champion was chosen.
11. Australian Native Species & Hybrids are defined as orchids found growing naturally in Australia and its Territories.
12. Mericlones will not be eligible for the First Flowering Seedling class.
13. Table Displays must include a minimum of 8 orchids from at least 3 different genera. Plants used must predominantly be orchids, but other foliage plants are allowed. Maximum table size is 1 metre x 1 metre.
14. The Junior section is only open to members of Ipswich Orchid Society who are under 18 years of age at the date of the show judging.

Ipswich Orchid Society - Show Schedule

SALES

1. The Ipswich Orchid Society is entitled to a 15% commission on all items through the sales area.
2. Every sales plant must have a Society approved barcode.
3. Only Ipswich Orchid Society Members, Sponsors and Visiting Exhibitors are entitled to sell plants.
4. Visitors must bench a minimum of 3 orchids to qualify for selling plants. There will be no limit on the sale of flowering orchids, but non-flowering orchids will be limited to 6 sale plants per 1 benched exhibition plant.
5. Only Ipswich Orchid Society members will be permitted to sell foliage or other non-orchid plants in the plant sales area. Visitors will not be permitted to sell any plants other than orchids.
6. All plants offered for sale must be in pots with the exception of hanging Vandas and mounted orchids. There are to be no bare-rooted plants or plants with roots wrapped in sphagnum and plastic. All plants must be well-established. Newly repotted, separated, or un-established plants will not be accepted in the plant sales area. Repeat offenders may be banned from future shows.
7. Entry to the plant sales area on the Friday night will be restricted to Ipswich Orchid Society members, Bromeliad Society members, visiting exhibitors, vendors, and judges. The Sales Co-ordinator reserves the right to refuse entry to anyone not involved in the above.
